What is a Day of Healing Prayer?

A Day of Healing Prayer is a time set aside for the Lord where participants can bask in His presence and receive prayer – in a confidential manner – from trained, experienced Prayer Ministers from St. Michael's Church. The day also includes teachings on specific areas of Christian healing. Sometimes we simply need to be still, sitting in God's loving presence to receive the healing of mind, body, and spirit that He has in store for us. Things to pray for: forgiveness, physical healing, grief (loss of family members, friends, home), broken hearts and relationships, career issues, etc.

The Healing Ministry at St. Michael's Church

The healing ministry at St. Michael's Church began in 1986. It has grown under the guidance of our clergy and lay leadership who are actively involved and supported by fifty trained lay Prayer Ministers.

St. Michael's Prayer Ministers receive comprehensive and ongoing training through Christian Healing Ministries Schools of Healing Prayer, Levels I, II, III, and IV; through the International Order of St. Luke the Physician; and through various other ministries, including those of Russ Parker, Presbyterian Reformed Ministries International, John Wimber of Vineyard Ministries, and Wagner Institute Publications.
