

What is a Day of Healing Prayer?

A Day of Healing Prayer is a time set aside for the Lord where participants can bask in His presence and receive prayer – in a confidential manner – from trained, experienced Prayer Ministers from St. Michael's Church. The day also includes teachings on specific areas of Christian healing. Sometimes we simply need to be still, sitting in God's loving presence to receive the healing of mind, body, and spirit that He has in store for us. Things to pray for: forgiveness, physical healing, grief (loss of family members, friends, home), broken hearts and relationships, career issues, etc.

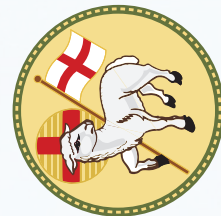
The Healing Ministry at St. Michael's Church

To many in the church, the word “revival” makes people squirm in their pew! It is, after all, a clergy person’s job to “Hatch ‘em, match ‘em, patch ‘em, and dispatch ‘em!” It is also a clergy person’s job to comfort the afflicted and to afflict the comfortable! Jesus did not *suggest* to his disciples to “preach the Kingdom and heal the sick”; he *commanded* them to do it. This life is not a dress rehearsal, but a response to the call of Christ that we may follow Him. Each individual, in each generation, has been given free will to discard Him, to follow Him, or to grow in Him. Revival invigorates and deepens a believer’s faith, opening his or her eyes to the truth in a fresh, new way. Do we need a spiritual reawakening from a state of dormancy or stagnation in our life? Give your Soul a gift, taste and see that the Lord is good.

The Rev. Nigel Mumford is an international speaker, author, and founder of *By His Wounds*, a non-profit ministry of Christian healing. Nigel is a former Royal Marine Commando with eight years in the corps, the last two as a drill instructor. In 1991, he dedicated his life to the healing ministry after his sister was dramatically cured of dystonia through prayer. Nigel has taught the healing ministry as an adjunct professor at six theological colleges and has spoken at many cathedrals and churches around the world, even at the Pentagon. He is the author of numerous books and articles on the healing ministry, including his most recent work, *Dying to Live: How Near-Death Experiences Transform our Faith*. He is a regular contributor to the Order of St. Luke’s *Sharing* magazine and has been interviewed several times on CBN and TBN. He currently serves as an associate priest at Galilee Church in Virginia Beach, VA. In his free time, Nigel enjoys boating, writing, playing the violin, and spending time with his “grand-triplets.”
