We are seeking a full-time worship leader who is well-versed in, and comfortable with, traditional and contemporary music. The person should be skilled on the piano and the organ. The ideal candidate will have the opportunity to help cast a new vision for our worship ministry as we move through these times of change and into the future.

This full-time position includes:

- + Overseeing three teams of musicians, which includes directing weekly choir rehearsals, recruiting new singers and instrumentalists of all ages
- + Developing a musical program for young people and children with a focus on encouraging youth participation in leading worship in the Flip Flops and Faith Family service.
- + Being a spiritual mentor and caretaker for all those who participate in the music ministry.
- + Developing relational opportunities for musicians and vocalists to collaborate and grow together
- + Consulting with the Rector and other worship leaders to select the music for all Sundays and special events.
- + Playing and directing singers for Sunday worship, weddings, and funerals (which includes scheduling substitutes in the event of an absence.
- + Hiring supplemental musicians needed for services within the limitations set by annual budget.
- + Planning additional musical outreach events during the year e.g recitals, concerts, musicals, special services.
- + Ensuring that we abide by copyright laws, and completing all required reporting of music used in the services.
- + Maintaining the music library and catalog, enlisting volunteers as needed. Ordering new music and curriculum within the allotted budget.

Our new worship leader will be a family oriented person of mature faith who is an active, contributing member of the staff, committed to the vision of Saint James: Love God. Love People. Build Community.
