Camp Jubilee Property Development

- Camp Jubilee Phase II Development Team continues to meet every other week
- Jay Ham hired as Project Manager (Compass Rose Development)
- We continue to work with Engineers, Architects, and Builders to move forward with Beaufort County to get our building permits in hand and to get “final approval” for the overall plan with the county.
- First Phase of building will include
 - All Infrastructure (Roads, Power, Water, Septic)
 - 6 Cabins (120 campers)
 - 4 Guest Cottages
 - Chapel Pavilion
 - Multipurpose Building (Meeting, Worship, Dining)
 - Welcome Center/Office
 - Maintenance/Equipment Shed
 - 2 Docks, Recreation Field, Pool

Camp Jubilee Capitol Campaign

- \$3.5 Million – gifts and pledges as of December 19, 2024 from over 400 total contributors (including parishes, businesses, clergy, and individuals)
- Need \$4.0M to complete all Phase I (\$3.7M sales price, \$300K due diligence)
