Anglican Missional Partnerships Committee

The committee met in advance of this August meeting of Diocesan Council on Monday August 18. This meeting included the opportunity to have Bishop Jeremiah Maet Paul, Diocese of Gambella, share with us about his diocese and his ministry. It also provided him the opportunity to be introduced to the committee members who represent each of the deaneries of the diocese. Gambella, one of the four dioceses that comprise the Anglican Province of Alexandria, is among our diocesan partnered relationship.

The committee received an update on the international guests that will be attending the New Wineskins conference that will also be hosted in the diocese either before or after the conference. At the committee's requests from funds that remained in the 2024 budget, a grant of \$5000 from the diocese was provided to New Wineskins for the purpose of providing scholarship assistance to international guests. Additionally, the Church of the Cross provided a grant of \$15,000 for the same purpose. These funds provided full support for eight of the eighteen scholarship recipients to attend the conference. Four of those hosted international guests will be visiting the diocese before and/or after the conference. Numerous other international guests will also be among us who are guests of individual parishes or ministries supported within the diocese.

New Wineskins 2025: Hope for the Nations


This triennial mission gathering is happening September 17-20, 2025, at Ridgecrest, North Carolina. Our diocese is typically the most represented among all the ACNA with over 120 registered thus far. Regular registration continues through August 2025, with late registration continuing through to the start of the conference. As of this week, registrations stand at just below 1400 participants, with over 40 nations represented.

Companion Relationship

Diocesan Council approved making the Anglican Province of Alexandria our official diocesan companion relationship. Three of the four diocesan bishops of this province will attend the New Wineskins conference in September, and two of these three have and will have time among us here in South Carolina.

The four dioceses of the Province of Alexandria include Egypt, Archbishop Samy Shehata; North Africa, Bishop Ashley Null; Horn of Africa, Bishop Martin Reaves-Williams; and Gambella, Bishop Jeremiah Maet Paul. All are encouraged to learn more about each of these bishops and their dioceses and to include them in your regular prayers personally and corporately as a church community. Opportunities for further engagement with any one or all these dioceses and their parishes is also encouraged for those seeking new or additional strategic missional relationships.
