



The Anglican Diocese of South Carolina Episcopal Visitation Customary 2025

DEADLINE: Complete and return this Customary 6 weeks before the Bishop's scheduled visit. This allows the bishop time to learn about your church, and how things are developing.

OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATIONS: If the visit requires overnight accommodations, the parish is asked to make those arrangements on the bishop's behalf.

PROTOCOL: The Liturgical Color appropriate to the Season may be used for the Bishop's Visit. If there are Confirmations, the color is traditionally Red, although the color of the season is also appropriate. The decision is left to the Rector.

The bishop normally wears his Rochet and Chimere, but is happy to wear his Cope and Miter if the church prefers.

The Bishop's Chaplain normally travels with him. If the Chaplain is not present, a Deacon will assume those responsibilities. If there is no Deacon, a priest or a lay person may serve as Chaplain. The bishop can easily explain the Chaplain's duties.

Due to the challenges of weekly travel, the bishop requests that multiple services be combined into one unless the combined ASA exceeds the capacity of the Nave. If you'd like an exception to be made, please contact the bishop and discuss it with him.

BISHOP'S DISCRETIONARY FUND: The open plate offering (or some alternative amount previously determined by the vestry) is customarily designated for the Bishop's Discretionary Fund. Those funds should be conveyed after the visitation at the convenience of the parish treasurer.

BAPTISM: Normally baptisms are not a part of an Episcopal Visit. If there is a reason that you'd like for the bishop to baptize (*ie.* the children of clergy) please call to discuss that with him.
