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Anglican Missional Partnership Committee

The committee met August 17 to receive updates about our diocesan sponsored missionaries, to review budgeted expenditures including funds raised toward CT-Scan Project requested from the Medical Partnership Office of the Anglican Diocese of Egypt. The committee remains in need of additional representation in either the clergy and lay order from the Orangeburg, Florence, Beaufort, and Charleston deaneries.

Fund Raising Project on behalf of our Companion Province of Alexandria / Diocese of Egypt

Within the diocese, \$50,000 was raised and given to the Medical Partnership Office of the Anglican Diocese of Egypt toward the purchase of a CT-Scan unit for use in the Harpur Memorial Hospital of Sadat City. The total cost of this unit is \$258,000 and funds can still be received to assist in this medical need. A special restricted fund has been created in our diocesan financial accounting system to receive and send all donated contributions to this project.

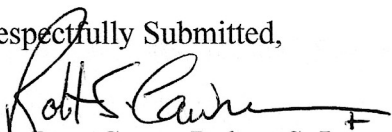
Diocesan Mission Course
